Key components of the logistics

Transportation The movement of goods from one location to another, typically by land, air, or sea.

Warehousing The storage of goods until they are needed for distribution.

Inventory management The tracking and control of goods throughout the supply chain.

Order fulfillment The process of picking, packing, and shipping goods to customers.

1 Rising costs

The cost of transportation, labor, and fuel is on the rise, putting pressure on logistics providers to improve efficiency.



2 Increasing complexity

Supply chains are becoming increasingly complex, as businesses expand into new markets and offer a wider variety of products.



3 Customer expectations

Customers are demanding faster and more convenient delivery options, which is putting pressure on logistics providers to innovate.



4 Sustainability

The logistics industry is a major contributor to greenhouse gas emissions, which is leading to increased scrutiny from regulators and consumers.


Types of Logistics Business Models
